- Reviewed by administrators
- Parents & Students usually print this checklist on Saturdays at noon.
- ONE required field: Homework
- VERY specific format
- Written and Saved in CT



## **Home-Day Lesson Plan Format:**

- ☐ Title of the lesson at the top.
- ☐ Title should be capitalized &/or bold.
- Steps of the lesson should begin with a line and number.
- Divide the steps of the assignment into simple, clear instructions. If you think a line is getting too long, split the step into two parts.
- Notes to parents should be at the bottom of the assignment.

### **Home-Day Lesson Plan Format:**

#### TITLE OF THE LESSON

- \_\_\_\_1. Location: The first line should always tell where the lesson is located.
- \_\_\_\_2. Do: The second line is the "do" or the activity.
- \_\_\_\_\_3. Practice: The next step in the lesson plan is any additional practice the student needs to complete either on their own or with the help of parents.
- \_\_\_\_\_4. Put Away: Always tell parents where the work needs to go, even if it is suppose to stay home.
- \*Parents Section: The star is a symbol we are going to use for parents information. Please use this as a symbol to guide parents that this is something they need to know or be aware of.

1. Take out your Mystery of History (MOH) textbook.
2. Before you read today's lesson answer this question, "What does forbidden mean?"
3. Read Lesson 77 pg. 445-448 in your MOH textbook (with your parent).
4. After you have read the lesson answer these questions out loud together:
*Why was the palace named "The Forbidden City"?
*Where was the Imperial City located?
*Do you think being isolated from the world is a good or bad thing? Why?
5. Watch video: Forbidden City Video*
